<u>Church Council Minutes</u> <u>May 6, 2014</u> (Abridged Edition)

7 members, plus Pastor McPike, attended the monthly council meeting held on April 1, in the fellowship hall.

Secretary's minutes were read and approved. Treasurer Bob Zimmerman reported the cash balance being \$72,295.57. The monthly mission giving project for May was previously approved for St. Johns Lutheran School in Champaign.

Pastor reported that he had talked to our summer vicar, Kurt Cockran. He will be moving here the end of May. He has also talked to Pastor Keffie Deen who will be filling in two times before the summer as Pastor McPike has family commitments. Pastor suggested that we pay him as a substitute pastor at \$200 a Sunday for these Sundays. Pastor Deen is not available from June – mid-August because he has pastoral duties at Thomasboro. Our summer vicar will fit into our summer schedule and then in late August we will discuss our financial arrangement for Pastor Deen.

Pastor McPike wanted feedback on how the new microphones are working. There still seems to be a buzz in the front of the church, but the recordings for the shut-ins are much better. He also supported the need for routine advertising of our congregation since sometimes we are forgotten because of our location. We now are included in the church directory in the Fisher paper and the Farmer City — LeRoy paper starting in June. Pastor is also working on improving the church's website.

Beth Bidner reported the progress of Vacation Bible School planning. It is scheduled for July 13-17. She has advertised for volunteers in the church bulletin. She asked the council for suggestions to

where the VBS offerings should go. The council discussed possible ways to get internet service for Vacation Bible School use.

Chairman Hardesty started the new business with the quest for housing arrangements for the summer vicar. Since this is only a 2 month stay the task may be a little more difficult. Larry Lutz volunteered to look for any Fisher rental possibilities and check out the expenses at an Extended Stay Hotel in Champaign.

Chairman Hardesty reported that we have made two payments to Kross Tuckpointing for our project. The third payment will be made when the project is complete to our satisfaction. The contractor did agree to install the lentil and the seal for the window in the annex. Dick Johnson will install the plate glass window which has thermal panes.

The council gave Bob Zimmerman permission to work on the new LP contract. Our old one with Illini FS expires the end of May.

The meeting was adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.

<u>Church Council Minutes</u> <u>Special Meeting</u> May 25, 2014

11 members, plus Pastor McPike, attended the special council meeting which was held after church on May 25 in the church.

Chairman Hardesty outlined the three options available for the housing for our summer vicar. The options were a 2-bedroom apartment in Fisher for \$425 a month, a 1-bedroom apartment in Bellflower for \$375 a month, or an extended stay hotel in Champaign for approximately \$250 a week which includes all amenities. After some discussion, Jeff Warsaw made the motion to house the vicar at the Fisher apartment. Larry Lutz seconded. Motion carried.

Chairman Hardesty then turned the meeting over to Bob Zimmerman for a discussion on the LP gas contract. Illini FS offered us a price of \$1.89 per gallon for 2200 gallons. After some discussion, the council suggested that we raise the amount of gallons to 3000 gallons for this contract since we went over our contract amount last year. Beth Bidner made the motion to raise the amount of gallons to 3000 at \$1.89 per gallon and stay with the same supplier which is Illini FS. John Gercken seconded. Motion passed.

Jeff Warsaw mentioned that Chief Bauer had been out to check the air conditioning units. However, they will be called back this week since the units kept shutting off during the church service this morning.

The meeting was adjourned.
